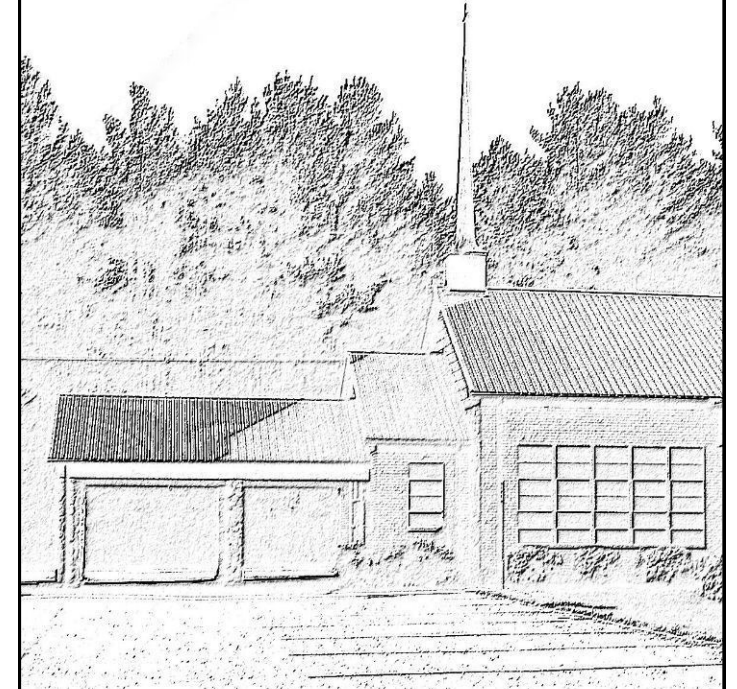

that we can affirm with Paul that we are content with weakness-
es for your sake, and fill us with the knowledge that it is when we
allow ourselves to be empowered by you, that we are truly
