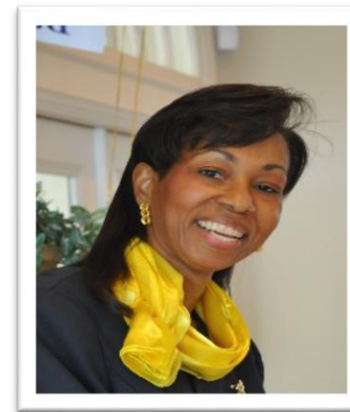
Tuesday June 20th-7:00PM

With a bachelor’s degree from UNC-Chapel Hill and a master’s degree from Duke University, Dr. Barrett began a career in human resources and training with Siecor and Corning, Inc., in 1986. In 2002, God led her out of the corporate world and directed her to found “The Word is My Life” Training Ministry. Through this ministry, Dr. Barrett teaches, counsels, and intercedes for those who desire to experience life-changing freedom and wholeness through God’s Word. She writes a bi-monthly ministry letter entitled “From My Life’s Journey” and ministers to women leaders in a ladies’ group called “Women With a Call.” A special focus of this ministry is the development of women called into ministry and other areas of leadership. God has called Dr. Barrett to disciple, mentor, and serve as a spiritual mother, pouring out the knowledge and wisdom of God into seeking souls by His Spirit. Dr. Barrett also serves as a Biblical counselor at Christian Community Outreach Ministries in Hickory and as an advisor/director of Bridges Bible College students at Christ Alive Church. Led by the Holy Spirit, Dr. Barrett pursued and received her doctorate degree in Adult Education from Regent University in 2012 and is now an adjunct professor teaching master’s and doctoral students online for Regent.
