Refrigerator Notes 21 February 2016 'Setting Our Goal On Jesus' Luke 13, 31-35

- 1. The scripture's sermonic title was obtained from v.32b, "on the third day I will reach my goal"...
- 2. The fact that was very pronounced was even Jesus had a goal in His life and His ministry
- 3. Who would have thought that Jesus would need to set a goal of any type, since He was the reincarnated Son of God?
- 4. That part of scripture, v.32b, should give us all a reason to pause in life and say, What goal(s) have we personally created in life
- 5. Although the scripture does not say what Jesus' Goal was, His goal must have been linked with that third day
- 6. The third day was the day of Jesus' resurrection that He was referring. v.3 3 Jesus says, "In any case, I must press on today and tomorrow and the next day—for surely no prophet can die outside Jerusalem!"
- 7. For Jesus knew that His death would not occur outside of Jerusalem, but in Jerusalem as foretold by prophecy
- 8. As I alluded earlier in sermon, the scripture was not pointing directly to Jesus' death or His resurrection, but that Jesus had set a 'Goal' for what He wanted or had to do before His death
- 9. "I will keep on driving out demons and healing people today and tomorrow, and on the third day I will reach my goal.' 33 In any case, I must press on today and tomorrow and the next day..."
- 10. Then I asked the question of DPC, Have you set your goal on Jesus?
- 11. Too often in life, achievers in particular, become goal setters to achieve their life dreams, wants, desires or successes, but Jesus is never included
- 12. Too often, the goals that we set are short term, medium term or Long term,
- 13. But never set our goal on being with Jesus
- 14. We seldom prepare for our dying, and yet, our only concerns are living for today and tomorrow
- 15. If you want to see Jesus then you must die
- 16. If you want resurrection, then you got to set your goal on Jesus
- 17. Wanting to be with Jesus than becomes a weighty matter, no a dream thing Because no one ever thinks of making Jesus their goal
- 18. There is one thing else Jesus requires of us, hard work 99% perspiration and 1% inspiration
- 19. If going to heaven is a goal, one must be like the prophets and write it on their hearts.
- 20. Jesus' goal was on the third day to be resurrected. If you got your mind set on Jesus, then you got to set your goal to die for Jesus.
